There in the remote village of Fimpulu, he met his wife Bethany. Together they have raised a family of three and led a ministry that includes a working farm, a camp & conference center and a primary school. Choshen Farm has grown to a well-known organization in the province, employing 65 Zambia farmers, teachers and support staff.

HOLISTIC MINISTRY

Choshen Farm's ministry has always been holistic in the sense that the Colvins model Jesus' love to their neighbors in the everyday tasks of life. They develop programs in partnership with the village with the intention of one day passing the leadership and ownership to the community. This plan is not a quick fix, but rather a long journey of building the capacity of leaders and the next generation. Our ultimate vision is to build the framework of an operation that will one day sustain the ministry beyond the need for external financial support.
